Full bar service is available on board (cash bar).

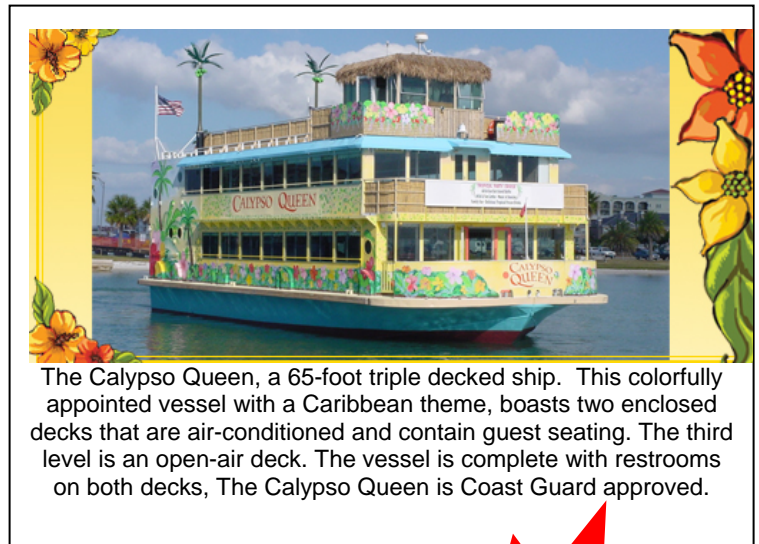
11:15am Tropical Island Style Buffet.
